

## BOARDING

Providence Equestrian Center (PEC) provides quality care, training, and instruction. It is owned by a veterinarian and staffed by equine professionals. We are able to use our knowledge, experience, and expertise to maintain sound, healthy, and well conditioned horses while helping equestrians of all levels achieve their riding goals.

Providence offers a beautifully constructed barn, 12x12 stalls cushioned with the "Comfort Stall" mat system, irrigated pastures, paddocks, automatic security gates, air conditioned and heated tack rooms with private lockers, heated wash stalls, built-in stall fans, indoor and outdoor lounge areas, sound system, perimeter riding trail, a covered 80 x 140 riding arena, and an outdoor 125 x 275 riding arena.

At Providence, every horse's healthcare is of the utmost concern. All horses are on optimum vaccination, deworming, dental and farrier programs. Turn-out groups are small or individual. Body condition and fitness is closely monitored. Board includes dewormers, yearly Coggins, blanketing, feeding supplements and a tack locker.



### Board Fees and Policies

**Board**- Includes one weekly lesson - \$975/month

**Full Training Board**- \$1300/month. 5 training rides/week

**Training rides**: \$35/ride, \$120 for 4 training rides

All other services are available by request.

Board is due the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, a \$50 late fee applies thereafter.

**A two month written notice is required if boarder terminates board agreement with PEC.**

Boarders must follow all PEC rules.
